**RECOGNISE** patterns within the number system

**COMPARE** quantities in different contexts and **SUBITISE**

To become an Exceptional Explorer who can:

Show **CURIOSITY** about the world around them by sharing their own knowledge and asking questions of others to find out more.

**UNDERSTAND** how to read and create a simple map

UNDERSTAND some DIFFERENCES between times and places

To become a Compassionate Citizen who can:

**KNOW** their place in their family and **UNDERSTAND** that events happened before they were born

Help to LOOK AFTER their community and CARE for the environment, including animals

Have an **AWARENESS** of other people's cultures and beliefs and **APPRECIATE** different religious and cultural communities in their own home town and around the world
